

NOTRE DAME-CATHEDRAL LATIN SCHOOL
STUDENT DRIVER AGREEMENT

All students who drive to school must follow the procedures in the Parent-Student Handbook for attaining a parking place. All drivers must: possess a driver's license; adhere to in and out arrows painted on the pavement; stop for pedestrians in crosswalks; follow all driving directives of the State of Ohio, and observe stop signs and speed limits (property is 20 mph; parking lot is 5 mph). Students are not to drive or ride in overloaded cars, not use the bus lane, and not pass on the property road. If someone has parked in your assigned spot please report the make of the car and license number to the office. Parking is not permitted in the Handicap or Visitor spaces. Notre Dame-Cathedral Latin School is not responsible for accidents occurring in the parking lot, or otherwise on school property. When an accident occurs on the property, the Chardon Police Department will be called to file a police report.

The following will be enforced:

1. Violations of the above will result in the following:
 - a) a fine of \$10.00 will be set for each traffic/speed violation;
 - b) a fine of \$25.00 will be set for each "stop" sign violation;
 - c) a major violation will be issued for any of the above violations.
2. Any harassment by language or action may be cause to inform the sheriff's office.
3. After the second violation, the driver and the car will become "trespassers" on this property, which is a more serious offense.
4. A fine of \$25.00 will be issued to any student who drives to school without obtaining a parking or day permit.
5. Students may have their driving privilege revoked by the Administration.

Students are to leave home early enough to arrive at school on time. Please refer to Parent-Student Handbook. They are to take into consideration traffic congestion, weather conditions, road work and detours. Those who are habitually tardy will be denied the privilege of driving. Students are expected to leave their cars and enter the building upon arriving at school. Once students have arrived at school, they are not permitted to leave the property without permission of the Administration. No student is permitted to go to his/her car during the school day without permission of the Administration. Cars may not be left in the lot overnight without the permission of the principal. Any car left without permission may be towed.
